## **Purchasing tickets:**

Tickets can be purchased by the following link:

All Box Offices are cashless. You will need to pay with a card.

Children aged 13 and under are free with a paying adult.

## **Companion cards:**

Australian Companion Cards are accepted for general admission tickets at the gate when attending with a paying guest who requires assistance. Please present your card at the gate.

## **Assistance animals:**

Approved assistance animals are accepted.

# Getting there

## **Accessible parking:**

Dedicated parking bays available on Maria Liveris Drive, near the entrance. To access the parking, approach the event from the Darwin CBD end of Gilruth Avenue. Please show your Australian Disability Parking Scheme Badge to the traffic controllers on arrival for access to the parking area.

For patrons being dropped off, the closest drop off point is on Atkins Drive. This can be accessed by approaching the site near Darwin High School. Head West on Goyder road then turn left on to Atkins Drive heading south to reach the drop off point.

# Getting there

## **Free public transport:**

All buses have low-floors and ramps to accommodate wheelchairs and light mobility aids. The festival offers free transport to the event from CBD locations. At the bus collection point our dedicated event champions have direct contact with the bus company to ensure getting onto the bus is an easy process. ## **Entering the event:**

There is a recommended entry lane at the Main Gate that has been modified for wheelchair access. The lane will be signed.

# Enjoying the event

## **Venue Access:**

The festival site itself is a grass area with hard sandy/rocky ground. The site has uneven ground.

Access around the catering area, wheelchair accessible toilets and throughout the Village area there is concrete and concrete paths. Some tree roots may still be apparent through this area.

It is important to note that the site is large, around 250m long and 200m wide with amenities and experiences spread across the area. Patrons with restricted mobility or those using mobility aids may need to consider this walking distance. Seating is available around the site.

## **Accessible bathrooms:**

Locations with accessible friendly bathrooms have been marked on the map on page 14.

## **Accessible platforms:**

Carpentaria Disability Services has partnered with NT Major Events to deliver the Carpentaria Accessibility Viewing Platform. It is open to anyone requiring access due to physical or intellectual mobility. The space is not reserved and is on a first-in basis with a general admission ticket.

## **Support and assistance:**

Event staff have completed the Hidden Disabilities Sunflower training and wear the sunflower supporter lanyards if you need assistance. Please speak to one of our friendly team members.

# Enjoying the event

## **Sensory information:**

At night the festival site is a low-light environment throughout pathways. Festoon and lighting towers are used to light amenities, pathways and site areas, however dark areas are still present.

The site features amplified music from a number of sources as well as moving lights, large LED screens and at peak times, large crowds.

Located near medical, the All Good Project will host a Low-Sensory Space. This is a dedicated area designed for festivalgoers who may feel overwhelmed by the high-energy environment. The Low-Sensory Space will provide a quiet, calming environment where attendees can take a break, recharge, and return to the action when they're ready.

Sensory Bags will be available free of charge (subject to availability) at the Hidden Disabilities Sunflower Booth in Chillout Cove.

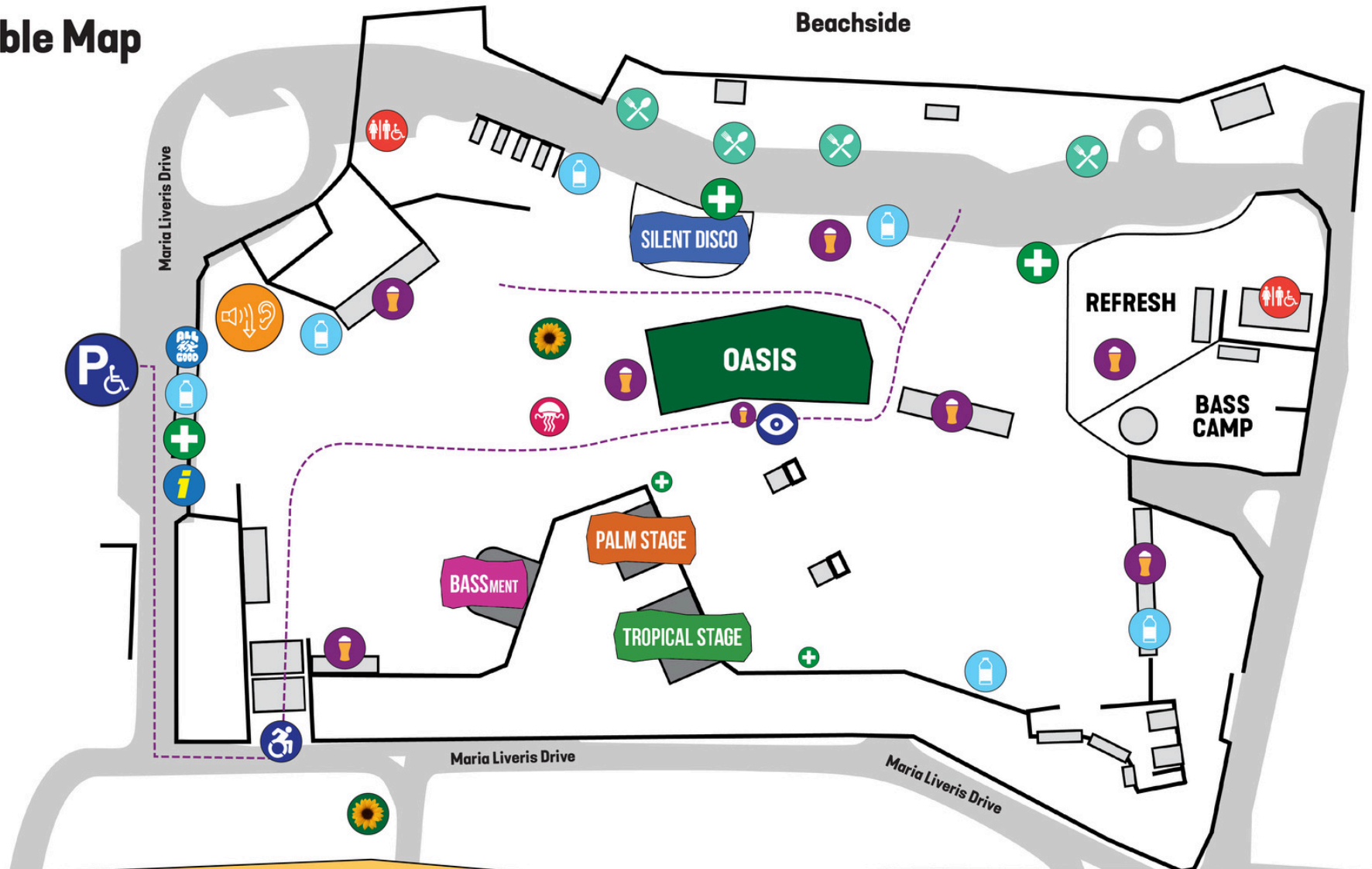
